

THE CZECH JUDICIAL ACADEMY IS A PARTNER IN INTERNATIONAL PROJECT:

Training Court Staff and Bailiffs in European Cross-border Civil and Criminal Law Procedures

Under the Justice Programme 2021-2027, ERA and EJTN are implementing a new project tackling the deficiencies of court staff and bailiffs training in European law in partnership with the European Union of Judicial Officers (UEHJ) and 15 national judicial training institutions.

Building on the knowledge and experience gained from the implementation of previous projects, and following the recommendations made in the recent “Study on the training needs of court staff on EU law in the EU” carried out by a consortium led by EJTN in collaboration with the EIPA, ERA and EJTN envisage to continue providing training in the EU law areas with practical relevance for court staff and developing coherent and innovative training packages for future use.

Objectives

- To organise interactive and practical legal **training activities for court staff (also bailiffs)** on EU civil and criminal law matters relevant for their judicial work.
- To improve the necessary basic language skills (reading, writing, speaking and listening) in terms of **legal terminology in English** amongst court staff and bailiffs.
- To provide **advanced training on selected EU instruments in civil and criminal matters as well as legal writing**.
- To provide up-to-date **standardised training packages** for setting up interactive seminars on EU civil and criminal law matters for court staff and bailiffs.
- To create a stand-alone **e-tool for legal English in criminal law matters**.
- To develop both **legal and linguistic skills** of court staff members and bailiffs and strengthen their competences to facilitate cross-border communication and cooperation.
